Dear Parents,

Our summer planning is under way at First Steps. We are excited to offer a fun program “Champions in Christ”, an olympic themed camp. Summer Camp will run from June 10 - August 16. Please note: Depending on the need, care may be available May 28 - May 31 and June 3 - June 7 for St. Matthew’s families who are attending summer camp.

Here is a summary of our program:

Summer camp is for children entering 5K - 6th grade. Depending on the amount of children registered we may have two separate groups broken down by classes, 5K & 1st grade and 2nd-6th grade.

There will be a daily schedule that includes devotions, summer reading challenge, an introduction to sports, and many age appropriate activities while spiritually growing in Christ. Field trips will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays each week. You will be charged a **non-refundable** fee for all field trips. If your child will be attending on a Tuesday and/or Thursday, it is **mandatory** they go on the field trip. You will be charged \$125 for Tuesday trips and \$125 for Thursday trips if your child attends both days per week your summer field trip fee will be \$250. You will receive the field trip charge(s) on Friday June 7.

You will be required to submit your child’s summer schedule form with your registration to ensure your child’s spot. List the days and general drop-off and pick-up times. Days must be consistent week to week.

Daily rates are \$57 per day or \$275 for a full week. Two snacks and lunch are provided.

If your child was already registered with First Steps for the 2023/2024 school year, you are registered through the summer and will not be charged an additional registration fee.

Tuition is due Fridays prior to the next week of service. Tuition can be taken by EFT, paid online by credit card, or by check in the office (listed in the preferred order).

We look forward to a great summer at First Steps. Please return the summer schedule form attached to this letter by April 1 to ensure your child’s spot.
